Uses for Concordance Tables – High School Testing

- Student Testing Program (STP) can use the associations to make STP Career Exploration materials more relevant for those considering college.
- College entrance exam scores can be forecast from AFQT scores.
 - ▶ Forecast = predict, estimate, speculate
 - ▶ Score ranges vice specific scores
- Students desiring to improve scores on standardized tests can be directed to the Army’s “March 2 Success” program at www.march2success.com.

Caveats for Using

- The concordances represent equivalent levels of performance based on group data, hence may not be exact for any given individual; however, the approximation is the best available.
- ASVAB, SAT, and ACT vary considerable in purpose and design.
- Tables can be employed to obtain “notional scores that are used for information purposes only.”
